




ภาพที่ 3.2 แผนภูมิแสดงแนวทางการวิเคราะห์แก่นเรื่อง

### Plot Diagram for "Romeo and Juliet"

Romeo is banished.



### Plot Structure of Romeo and

Juliet Climax or Turning Point: Tybalt kills Mercutio, then Romeo kills Tybalt. The Prince arrives and orders that Romeo be banished

from vona.

Rising Action: Romeo needs to secretly marry Juliet fearing that a Capulet and a Montague would never be allowed to mary.

Falling Action: Paris will soon be married to Juliet, and the Capulets do not know about Juliet's secret marriage. Juliet decides to fake her death with a potion the Friar gives her.

Exciting Force: Romeo meets

Juliet at the Capulet house and completely forgets about Roszine.

Moment of Final Suspense:

Romeo is informed that Juliet is dead when she is really asleep from the potion. Romeo arrives at the Capulet burial vault ready to drink the poison the Apothecary and him.

Exposition: Romeo shows his lust for Rosaline: normal conversations in Montague and Capulet families; Mercutio makes fun of Romeo because of Rosaline's intent to never marry.

Catastrophe: Romeo drinks the poison and dies. Juliet wakes up, finds Romeo dead, and kills herself with a dagger when the Friar is not looking. Both families agree to stop the hatred after the tragedy.







### Freytag's Plot Structure Pyramid on Macbeth



The Reversal (climax, turning point))
Macbeth has Banquo killed

This is the turning point because

The Lord's have a conversation that shows they see through Macbeth's lies.

Motifs (recurring images): Hands, Heaven, Hallucination, Sight.

Concepts: Greed, Selfishness, Power, Ambition, Violence, Murder, Death.

THEME: The pursuit of power is ultimately pointless if one loses sight of that which is truly valuable.

#### **Rising Action**

4th Event: Macbeth is named King of Scotland

3rd Event: Macbeth kills Duncan

2nd Event: Malcolm is named Duncan's

successor

#### Inciting Event:

When Macbeth finds out he is the Thane of Cawdor

#### Exposition

Setting: Outside in open ground.

Characters Introduced: Macbeth is introduced by The witches, A sergeant tells of the heroic deeds

of Macbeth

Situation: Macbeth is considered a war hero as he fights and defeats all of the King's enemies.

The Denouement (the final battle) happens when Birnam wood comes to Dunsinane and Macbeth fights Macduff and is killed.

This is the Denouement because Macbeth's death results in Peace for Scotland.

#### Resolution


happens when Macbeth is killed and Malcolm is crowned king.

This is the Resolution because Scotland is once again a peaceful place with a rightful king on the throne





The queen realizes that Oedipus is her son.

Climax

Oedipus goes to look for the man who killed the king of Thebes.

Oedipus goes to a theater, meets the Queen of Thebes (tomato) and has a child with her.

Oedipus meets a broccoli, fights him, and kills him.

Exposition

The queen kills herself.

Oedipus realizes that the broccoli he killed was his father.

Oedipus pokes out his own eyes.

Oedipus says goodbye to his two daughters, Antigone and Ismene, and exiles himself from Thebes forever.

#### Messenger from Corinth


Herdsman

### **Oedipus**

The king of Thebes, married to Jocasta. He is unaware, at the start of the play, that he has murdered his father and slept with his mother. In the end ultimately, however, Oedipus must pay the price for dismissing the Oracle's prophecy.



#### Ismene and Antigone

Oedipus's young daughters who are led out at the end of the play. Oedipus laments the fact that they will never find husbands with such a cursed lineage and begs Creon to take care of them.

#### Chorus of Theban

a group of men who serve as an emotional sounding board and expositional device in the play, r on the plot developments while important philosophical questio



Here's how the lovers go down:




The Montagues and Capulets have a duel. At the end, Verona's Prince says, "the next to fight will die."
